

NIC SUMMER CAMP CHECKLIST & FAQ

WHAT TO BRING

ESSENTIALS

- Bible
- Flashlight
- Insect Repellent
- Laundry Bag
- Pen & Notebook/Notepad
- Pillow and pillow case
- Sleeping Bag, or twin sheets
- Sun Block
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, etc)
- Towel

CLOTHING

- Jacket
- Pants & Shorts
- Shoes
 - sturdy for hiking
 - water or old ones for wading
 - comfy for lounging around
- Socks
- Swim Suit - (modest one-piece, **NO bikinis, NO swim briefs** [a.k.a. *speedos*])
- T-shirts (we provide one themed T-shirt)
- Underwear
- Rain Gear (poncho or jacket)

CAMP STORE / SPENDING MONEY / CASH

If you send cash with your camper, we record the total and lock it in our safe—we then keep a running tab which we deduct from their balance. Remaining balances on the last day of camp will be refunded if they are > \$1. If < \$1, they will be recorded as donations.

REQUIRED FORMS (<http://nicoutdoors.org>)

- Camper Release (*at check-in*)
 - Tells us to whom we may release your camper—Photo ID required at pick-up.
- Health History ([view online](#))
 - *New Health Forms must be completed and returned 2 weeks prior to camp so that our Camp Nurse may review them.*
 - *Camp Nurse might call to verify/clarify information on the Health Form.*
 - Doctor's signature is no longer required.
- Permission / Behavior ([view online](#))
 - Formally verifies the parent's/guardian's permission for the camper to participate, and the camper's commitment to abide by camp behavior rules.

CAMPER MEDICATION

If your camper needs medication during camp, please **bring it/them to the registration table in their original containers (bottles)**, with the camper's name, doctor's name, and dosage instructions so that the Camp Nurse may review and verify them—**a legal requirement.**

PARENT / GUARDIAN NOTIFICATION

We attempt to contact parents/guardians if a camper shows symptoms of an illness or injury that requires treatment by a medical professional. If unable to reach them, we will contact the next listed emergency contact.

Homesick campers are not allowed to call home until after a staff member has spoken with the camper's parent/guardian.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

- Campers share cabins with other campers, —there are no lockable spaces.
- Neither NIC, Outdoor & Retreat Ministries, Reynoldswood, nor Wesley Woods shall be responsible for lost or damaged personal property.
- Each Site reserves the right to search and seize personal property when possession of illegal or prohibited objects and/or substances is suspected.
